Foundation Stage (Year R) children in general will engage with aspects of Christianity and the other religion being explored in Key Stage 1. **Christianity & Judaism**

At Key Stage 1 children are required to study Christianity and one other religion. **Christianity & Judaism**

At Key Stage 2 children are required to study Christianity and two other religions.

In Years 3 and 4 this will be Christianity and one other religion and in. **Christianity & Hinduism**

Years 5 and 6 children are required to study Christianity and a different religion. In upper Key Stage 2 a non-religious world view may be included in addition. **Christianity & Islam**

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Teachers at Key Stage 2 must liaise with Key Stage 1 teachers to ensure three religions in addition to Christianity are explored through the primary years.
