Policy for Managing Drugs Related Incidents

The Samuel Cody School has a zero tolerance policy towards the possession, use or supply of illegal and other unauthorised drugs within school boundaries due to the extreme vulnerability of the pupils who attend the school. (See whole school procedure for behaviour management policy). Bringing unauthorised drugs into school will lead to permanent exclusion.

In order to manage drug related matters the school has a designated Drug Education Co-ordinator who will follow the designated procedure of the management of the discovery of illegal substances in school and who will liaise at all times with the Headteacher (or Deputy Headteacher in the absence of the Headteacher).
